

Step by Step Clean Regatta Registration and Certification Overview


- Before beginning, make sure you are a registered user.
- **Step 1:** Register your regatta by providing basic event information.
 - **Step 2:** Select the Best Practices you plan to achieve and view your anticipated certification level.
 - Download the Clean Regattas Toolkit to get ideas for ways to achieve each best practice.
 - Ask fellow regatta organizers for advice on the discussion forums.
 - Implement these initiatives at your event.
 - **Step 3:** Submit your event for certification and offer feedback on the program.
 - **Step 4 (for Platinum Level only):** Submit a sustainability report.


Changing Your Password

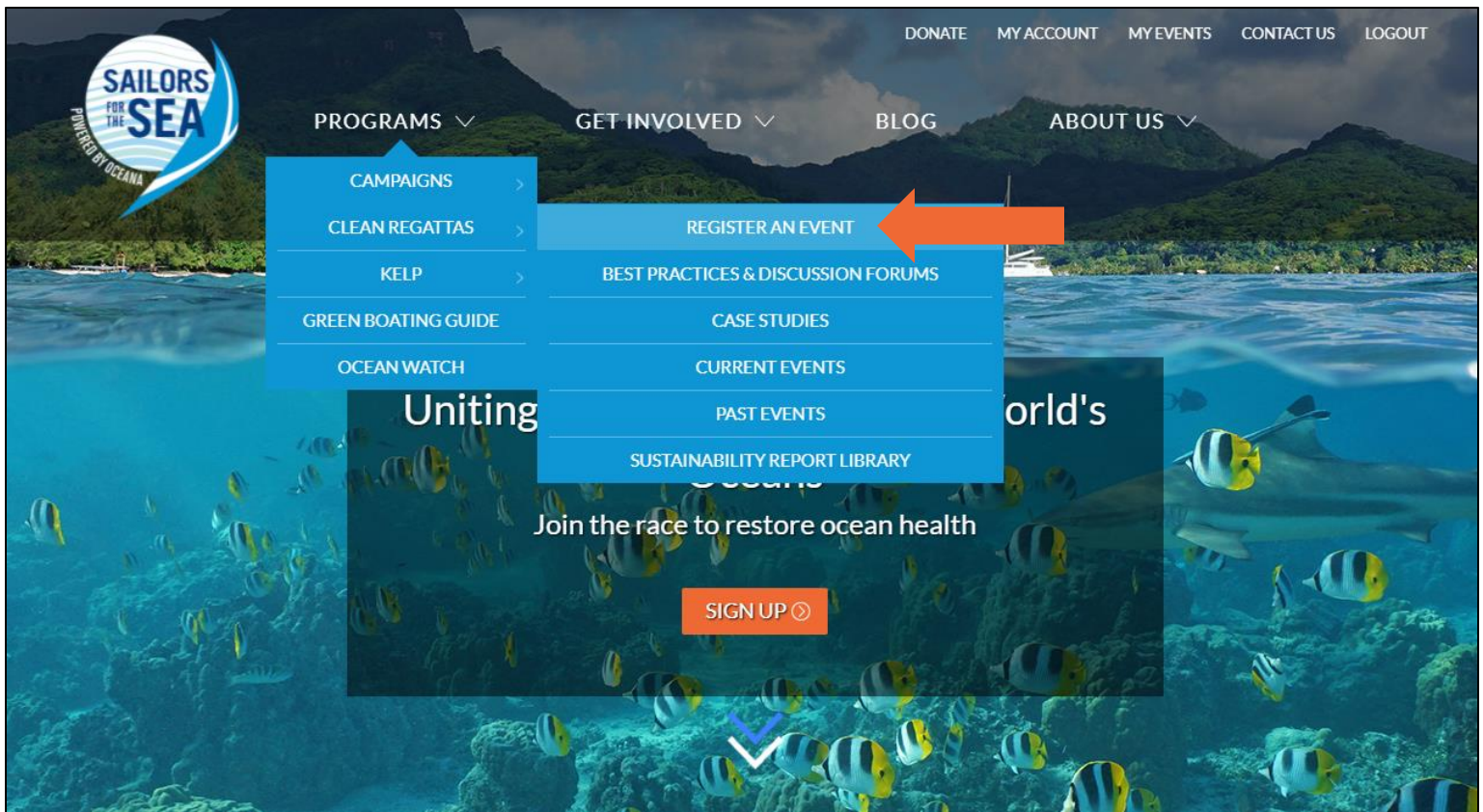

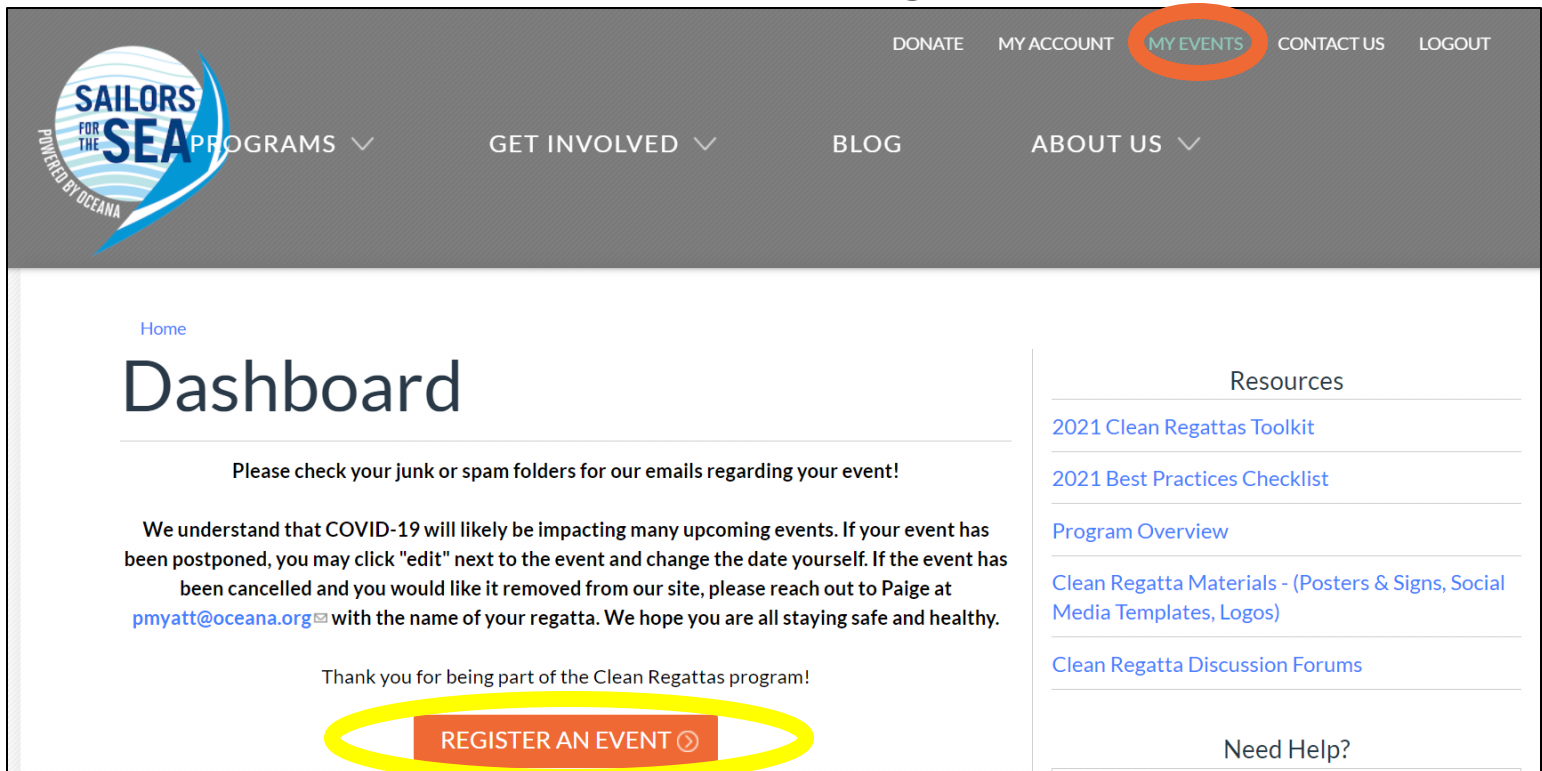
