
Promote Alternative Transportation

We are committed to the welfare of the wildlife that abounds in and around the harbor. Please observe the "No Wake" markers in Westpoint Slough as the habitat on Greco Island supports several endangered species. There is no landing permitted on Greco Island, nor on Bair Island, where they abut Redwood Creek.
