

#### Introduction

- The Yacht Club of Greece (YCG) hosted the Hellenic ORCi Nationals from the 3d of September 2024 till the 8<sup>th</sup> of September 2024. The event took place at the Saronic Gulf with 21 boats entering the regatta and around 250 crew members.
- The event was sponsored by Vodafone Foundation to promote among the Greek sailing community the Vodafone Posidonia program, a strategic initiative concerning the mapping and public awareness for the protection of *Posidonia Oceanica* underwater seagrass meadows in the Greek seas via responsible anchoring.
- The YCG Organizing Committee (OC) in parallel to the Posidonia program, executed a number of sustainability measures within the framework of the Sailors for the Sea program anticipating Platinum Certification.










#### Introduction

## Eliminate Single-Use Water Bottles and Provide Water Refill Stations







The OC installed two Water Refilling Stations at the club's boat park area. Both have water filtering and water-cooling capabilities of 200 litres of fresh water per hour. In parallel the OC included in the competitors pack one water cooler refill bottle for every sailor and delivered them during the registration. The measure was very well adopted by all the crew members who realized that apart of their contribution to the reduction of plastic they can have cold water throughout the day.

After the regatta the measure has been adopted by all the sailing teams, coaches and young sailors coming to the club to enjoy sailing.



#### **Eliminate Plastic Straws**



The use of Plastic Straws was strictly prohibited during the event. All the drinks of the dinners were served in disposable paper cups which have been recycled at the end of each day




### Serve Food with Plastic-Free Dinnerware

## Ensure Proper Waste Bin Placement and Signage






### **Divert Food Waste from the Landfill**

YCG has a program in place for distributing uneaten meals to the local Piraeus old peoples home. This program has been in place since the early 2000's




## **Use Paperless Event Management**

The Racing Rules of Sailing Platform has been used as the official communication channel between the Organizers, the Race committee, the Jury and the competitors. The event run totally paperless which is a common practice in YOG regattas.







## Host a Beach or Marina Cleanup









During the regatta we organized a cleanup of our Marina by the sailors of our ILCA team.



### **Promote Alternative Transportation**



We offered daily transportation by the sea for some crews who moored their boats in other marinas of the Saronic Golf. We offered two of our ribs with 2 coaches to transfer the crews from our club to their marina and vice versa.











#### Increase Awareness of Wildlife and Habitat Protection





We provided a seminar about responsible anchoring to preserve Posidonia underwater meadows via responsible anchoring in the Greek Waters.



### Offer Vegetarian or Vegan Alternatives

All of our meals (prepared by our partner, Bully Bar Concept) @bullybarconcept had vegetarian alternatives. Further as all dishes throughout the National Championship were based on Greek local dishes (which is primarily a vegetarian cuisine) this was easy for us to provide




## **Use Eco-Smart Management Techniques**

- We introduced (first time in Greece) the use of robotic marks to setup the race courses of the regatta.
- We rent 4 robotic marks from a Swiss specialized company and we have set all the race courses with these marks without the need to use our ribs, people and anchors.
- The marks were positioned remotely by the race committee.







## **Prevent Toxins from Entering the Water**

Racing boats were encouraged to use water only washdowns and were not allowed bottom cleaning throughout the regatta.
